

All of Dad's free time is now spent playing with us and bouncing between baseball games and dance recitals.

Why Light Your Landscape?



Third, is the location of the lights. Your focus should be on your plants during the day and not your lighting fixtures. A good lighting design will "bury" and screen the fixtures so they blend into the landscape.

Leahy Landscaping, Inc. uses these fundamentals to design and install a landscape lighting system that will leave you feeling safe and allow you to enjoy your landscape for years to come.

Landscape lighting is a great way to frame your house and create a safe path for children and guests around your property.

Every landscape lighting design is based on a standard set of three fundamentals:

1. Intensity of light
2. Choice of fixtures
3. Location of the lights.

There are three levels of light intensity which include bright, medium and soft.

Bright light distinguishes focal points and depth.

Medium light provides transitions between focal points.

Soft light defines paths, driveways and sidewalks.

By combining these three elements, you are naturally drawn into the property. This will create the opportunity for you to spend endless hours of enjoyment within your landscape.

Second, is the selection of the fixture type. This design decision is based on how the fixture will relate to the architecture of the house and the surrounding landscape. We primarily use brass fixtures because of their durability and aesthetic appeal.

We combine the creative talents of our professionally trained and certified designers with the efficiency of the construction crew to develop landscapes that last a lifetime.



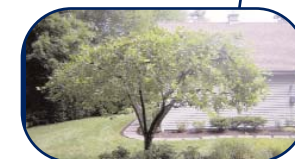
Commercial/Residential Maintenance
